What should I do if I see anti-social drinking?

While over 18s are permitted to drink responsibly in public, anti-social drinking will not be tolerated on any of our open spaces. Little Bowden Recreation Ground is covered by a Public Space Protection Order and it is an offence to refuse to hand over your alcohol to a police officer if asked to do so. If you witness any anti-social drinking, please report this to the police by filing it online at www.leics.police.uk or if the anti-social behaviour is ongoing by contacting them via telephone on 101.

What should I do if the litter bins are overflowing?

We empty our litter bins frequently to try to ensure that none are left overflowing. With the increase in waste being produced, and the surge in use of these open spaces, additional clean-ups and collections have been arranged to maintain this. Residents should take any litter home with them if they are unable to dispose of the waste appropriately. If you do find a litter bin that is overflowing, you can report this by completing our online street cleaning form on the Harborough District Council website, via the following link: www.harborough.gov.uk/report. Alternatively, you can contact our customer services team via the telephone number and email address at the top of this letter.

What should I do if I see littering?

Anyone caught littering by our environmental crime officers will be issued with an on-the-spot £150 fine. Littering can be reported to our customer services; however, we do require photographic evidence or video footage of the offence to be able to issue fines to those involved. You can report any incidences of littering at envirocrime@harborough.gov.uk

What should I do if I find drug paraphernalia?

If you come across any drug paraphernalia, please report this by visiting the Harborough District Council website and searching 'street cleaning' or by typing in the following link: www.harborough.gov.uk/report. Alternatively, you can do this by contacting our customer services team via the telephone number or email address at the top of this letter. There is out of hours cover for emergency issues, such as needles.

How can I report anti-social behaviour?

Anti-social behaviour should be reported to the police. If it is an emergency and you need support right away, please call 999. If it is not an emergency, then please report online at www.leics.police.uk or call 101 to report the incident if the anti-social behaviour is ongoing.

How can I report dog fouling?

You can report any incidences of dog fouling at envirocrime@harborough.gov.uk.

How can I report drug usage?

Drug usage should be reported to the police. If it is an emergency and you need support right away, please call 999. If it is not an emergency, then please visit www.leics.police.uk or call 101 to report the incident.

How can I report noise/nuisance complaints?

Any noise/nuisance complaints need to be reported to our environmental health team. You can fill out the online form by visiting the Harborough District Council website at www.harborough.gov.uk/environmental-health or alternatively, you can report it by calling or emailing our customer services team using the information at the top of this letter.
